Gregory Dean Maxey of Grasonville, MD, died Saturday October 16, 2010, at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 53.

Born March 18, 1957, in Tulsa, OK, he was the son of Sue Maxey Christmann and the late, Wallace Maxey. Gregory graduated from Edison High School and attended University of Tulsa. He enjoyed the Chesapeake Bay and all water related activities.

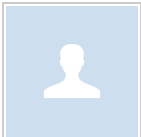

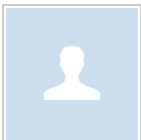
