Greg made friends everywhere he went because he truly cared about people and wanted to make them smile. He has a fabulous memory, even if he only met someone once, he remembered their name. He loved handing out balloons to children at the Kent Plaza to make them happy. Before he lost his car, Greg enjoyed his daily cup of coffee at one of the shops in Chestertown. He always had a joke to tell to brighten up the day and no one will forget his infectious laugh. He attended the Methodist Church in Worton and St. James

United Methodist Church. He loved attending Bible Study, church choir practice, and prayer meetings during the week. He was very faithful in his belief in God and loved his church community very deeply. He touched a lot of lives in various ways and will be missed by all who knew him.

Greg is survived by his sister, Diana S. Georgeson and husband Jim of Rock Hall; a brother, Robert Allen Mullins of Columbus, OH; two nieces, Samantha Georgeson of Rock Hall, MD; and Heather Georgeson, of Baltimore, MD.

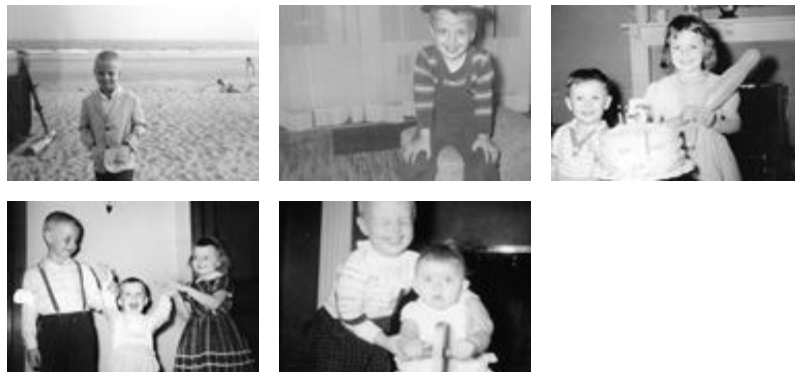
