Gregory Bentham Sherwood of Queenstown, MD, passed away suddenly on July 5, 2019, at the University of Maryland Shore Emergency Center in Queenstown, MD. He was 48.

Born on January 22, 1971, in Providence, RI, he was the son of Geoffrey B. and Dawn Sherwood. He was a graduate of South River High School, Class of 1989, and a graduate of Salisbury University.

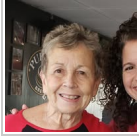

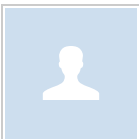
