Gregory Lank Steiner of Easton, MD died on Monday, August 30, 2004. He was 38.

Born in Milford, DE, October 15, 1965, he was the son of Donald Lawrence and Marie Dillon Steiner of Milford. After completing his public education, he attended Wake Forest University, where he received his BS degree in 1987. While there he was a member of Kappa Sigma and the R.O.T.C. He remained in the U.S. Army reserve for several years. He then earned his MBA at Emory University where he was Phi Beta Kappa. While living in Atlanta, he worked as a financial consultant for Ernst & Young, then in business development for MCI and finally as an independent contractor for Tel Com Cost Control. In June of 2003, he moved to Easton and joined his family's oil and propane delivery service business, Service Energy, LLC in Milford, DE. At the time of his death, he was owner-operator of Clean Delaware, Inc., an environmental service company.

An avid runner who participated in a full Iron Man Triathlon, he also enjoyed listening to music, particularly Jam bands.

Surviving in addition to his parents, are his wife, the former Amanda Matule, whom he married in Wilmington, NC on October 11, 1997; a sister, Tracy Steiner McGowan of Richmond, VA; and a brother, Michael Lawrence Steiner

of Wilmington, DE.

Memorial services will be held at Christ Episcopal Church, Easton, where he was a member, on Thursday, September 2, 2004 at 11:00 AM.

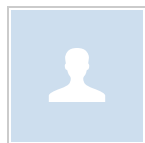
