STEVENSVILLE, MD: Gregory Robert Mill of Stevensville, MD died Thursday, February 16, 2006 at his residence after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. He was 41.

Born on May 31, 1964 in Davenport, Iowa, the son of Diane Goetsch and the late Charles Mill. At the age of five, Mr. Mill moved to Baltimore and then to Severna Park where he graduated from high school. He attended UMBC for four years earning a degree in Sociology. He then became a partner in the family business of Maryland Equipment and Party Rental and later Deer Park Building Supplies located in Randallstown, MD. In December of 1986, he moved to the Kent Island area. In 1989 he married Susan Braland. Mr. Mill spent twenty-four years working on building the family business and was also a Notary Public. He was a member of the Kent Island Yacht Club and St. Christopher's Catholic Church. He loved living on Kent Island and enjoyed fishing, boating and restoring classic cars. He also loved supporting his children in their sporting activities.
