October 14, 1936 - February 3, 2012

Greta Cox Walbert of Chestertown, MD, died on February 3, 2012, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 75.

She was born on October 14, 1936 the daughter of the late, Joseph George and Edna Elizabeth Covey Cox. She moved to Kent County where she met and married William Leon Walbert on March 2, 1956.

Mrs. Walbert raised her family and later worked briefly with Washington College and Kent County School System before starting the first state licensed daycare provider for children in Kent County. "Miss Greta's" was a welcomed service to many working families in Kent County. She owned and operated the child care service until the early 1980's.

Mrs. Walbert was a charter member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, a former member of the Woman's Literary Club of Chestertown, and served as a member of the Chestertown Volunteer Fire Company Ladies Auxiliary. In her younger years she was involved in volunteering with the school system, scouting, and the homemakers. Mrs. Walbert was an avid birdwatcher, and loved gardening, flower arranging, reading, making crafts, celebrating holidays, knitting, and most of all visiting with her family.

She is survived by her husband, William Leon Walbert, Jr. of Chestertown; a

daughter, Marian W. Wyble and her husband, Hugh of Chestertown; a son, William Leon Walbert, III, of Rock Hall, MD; a brother, William Cox of Jay, ME, and two granddaughters, Brittany Elizabeth Walbert and Shannon Wyble.

Services will be held on Saturday, February 11, 2012, at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, 905 Gateway Dr., in Chestertown at 11a.m.

Interment will be held privately in Chester Cemetery.
