



Hadley "Hal" Jensen

August 1, 1922 - November 1, 2014

Hadley (Hal) Jensen, of Easton, MD, died peacefully on November 1, 2014, at the Talbot Hospice House, surrounded by his family. He was born on August 1, 1922, in Oslo, Norway, the son of Julia Torkelsen Hagga and Olaf Daniel Jensen.

His family immigrated to the United States when he was a baby, briefly living in Salt Lake City, UT, before settling in Chicago, IL. After completing his second year at the University of Chicago, he joined the United States Marine Corps and served his country during World War II. He was discharged in late 1945 with the rank of Captain. After the military, he joined his father in the masonry trade, specializing in stone work for houses of worship in Georgia and Florida.

He married Hughie Cleveland Chambers on February 2, 1957, in Georgia, and they lived for almost 30 years in Georgia and Florida. They retired to Easton in 1985. After his wife's death in 2006, he worked at the Giant Food in Easton. He was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints and a 50+ year member of the Masonic Lodge.

He is survived by his stepdaughter, Sara Lou (Donald) Casson of Easton; his former stepdaughter in-law, Audrey Chambers of Georgia; six step-grandchildren, Cynthia (William) Morton, Donald (Kimberly) Casson, Leslie

(Craig) Stevens, Richard (Anne) Casson, Eugene (Susan) Chambers, and Ellen (Larry) Littleton; and 13 step-great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 49 years, and his stepson, Eugene Chambers.

A memorial service will be conducted by President Edwin McNeal of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in the chapel of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton on December 7, 2014, at 2 p.m. Interment will be private.
