Harmina Duisman Guest, 96, a resident of Annapolis, MD and formerly of Bowie, MD and Washington D.C., died of old age on September 11, at Anne Arundel Medical Center.

Born on February 18, 1906 in Parkersburg, Iowa, she was the daughter of the late Siebo and Thalia Duisman. She attended teacher's college there and was a school teacher in a one-room school in Iowa before moving to Washington, D.C. to work for the Federal Government in 1926. On August 8, 1930, she married Samuel Reeves Guest who predeceased her in 1944. She worked for a number of Federal Government organizations during her career and completed her government service with the Department of the Army, Deputy Chief of Staff for Logistics in 1968. While retired, she traveled extensively throughout the United States, Alaska and much of Europe. She was very interested in her families endeavors and activities and enjoyed gardening, wildlife and national parks.

Surviving are one son, Roger Reeves Guest of Stevensville, MD; three grandsons, Samuel, Marc and Andrew who all live in the Annapolis area and six great-grandchildren.
