



Harold A. McAllister

October 15, 1929 - March 28, 2008

Harold A. McAllister of Easton, MD, died Friday March 28, 2008, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 78.

Born on October 15, 1929, in Chicago, IL, to the late Harold A. McAllister, Sr., and Mae Louise Robinson McAllister. He attended Woodrow Wilson High School, graduating Class of 1948. On September 23, 1950, he married D. Joan Turner and they resided in Washington, DC, moving to Hyattsville shortly after.

Mr. McAllister enlisted with the Air National Guard and due to an injury, was honorably discharged in 1953. He then began working for the DC Government in the Highway Division. In 1956, he started with the U.S. Navy, working as a fluid systems designer on board Navy vessels including atomic submarines, aircraft carriers, DDG-51 destroyers, and others. Because of his career with the military, in 1956, he and his family began to move around the country, residing in Florida for seven years, Connecticut for five years, and Mare Island, California, for two years. It was in 1985, when he and his wife came to the Eastern Shore of MD, making their home in Grasonville. In 2005, they retired to Hyde Park in Easton.

Mr. McAllister is a member of the First Baptist Church of Kent Island. He and his wife are very involved in volunteering for the Tuckahoe Park and the Ward

Foundation.

Mr. McAllister and his wife, Joan, have three children, Bruce A. McAllister, Terry E. McAllister, and Roy S. McAllister; and three grandchildren, Katherine F. McAllister, Emily J. McAllister and Molly V. McAllister; and a great grandson, Cameron A. Cole.

A memorial service will be held at 2PM on Saturday, April 26, 2008, at the First Baptist Church of Kent Island, 300 State Street in Stevensville, MD, and interment will be private. The family requests that memorial contributions be made to the First Baptist Church in Stevensville.
