Harold “Bob” Franklin Chance, Sr., of Grasonville, MD, died on May 17, 2001, at The Pines Genesis Eldercare in Easton. He was 78.

Born on February 12, 1923 in Easton, he was the son of the late William and Margaret Hubbard Chance. After attending Easton High School, he served in the Navy during WW II. He was honorably discharged and returned to Easton, MD. and began working for McCord’s Laundry in Easton as a salesman in Talbot & Kent Counties. He married Reba Margaret Seward on June 10, 1950. They moved to the Washington area where Mr. Chance worked for National Airport as a manager for the skycaps. They later moved to Grasonville, MD. Mr. Chance then worked for BWI also as a manager of the Skycaps. After retiring from BWI, he resided in Grasonville, MD.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a son, Harold Chance, Jr., of Easton; six sisters, Carolyn Williamson of Preston, Jean Arnie of Preston, Phyllis Butler of Greensboro, Dorothy Lord of Federalsburg, Elaine Pressley of Easton, and Evelyn Stafford of Greensboro. One brother, Charles “Hotdog” Chance, predeceased him.
