November 29, 1915 - July 28, 2008

Harold Horner of Denton, MD, formerly of Easton, MD, died quietly at Homestead Manor, Denton, MD, where he had resided for three years, on Monday, July 28, 2008. He was 92.

Born November 29, 1915, in Somerset County, MD, he was the son of the late, Roland and Emma Timmons Horner of Mt. Vernon. Mr. Horner was the co-founder and co-owner along with his father-in-law, Elmer Golt, of the H. & G Restaurant which opened in 1947 and was family owned until 2005. He was also a banker and bookkeeper prior to opening the restaurant. During World War II, he had served in the U.S. Army.

He was a member of the American Legion Post #70, Easton, MD.

Mr. Horner is survived by his loving wife of 71 years, Eleanor Golt Horner; three children, Kay Parkinson and her husband, Clifford of Mt. Vernon, Robert Horner and his wife, Adele, of Easton, MD, and Joan Coble and her husband, Les, of Easton, MD; a brother, Emmons Horner and his wife, Virginia; four beloved grandchildren, Patty Culver, Robb Horner, Tyler Horner and Captain USMC Christopher Coble; and four great-grandchildren, Kendall, Madelyn, Philip and Caroline.
