Harold Joseph Kennedy, Sr., of Chestertown, MD, died on July 28, 2006, at Perry Point Veterans Hospital. He was 83.

He was born in Philadelphia, PA, the son of the late Howard J. Kennedy and Pauline Lewis. He grew up in Pennsylvania and New Jersey. In 1947, he married Bertha Lillian Himmelwright and lived in Pennsylvania. Mr. Kennedy served his country during World War II in Pearl Harbor, New Guinea, and the Philippines. He was honorably discharged.

After residing in several different cities and towns across the United States, Mr. Kennedy moved to Betterton in 1960 where he resided until 1989.

In 1979, he purchased Pomona Store and ran the store until his retirement when he moved to Florida in 1989. He also owned and operated Kennedy Roofing for 40 years.

In 1995 his wife predeceased him.

Mr. Kennedy was a Past Commander of the Betterton American Legion, a charter member of Millington V.F.W. and Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown; he was also a member of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association. He was very involved with Angels Haven (Kent

Center). Mr. Kennedy loved golf and was a member of Chester River Yacht and Country Club where he played with M.I.S.G.A. He also enjoyed playing cards and practical jokes.

He is survived by four sons; George E. Kennedy, Sr. of Chestertown, MD, Harold J. Kennedy, Jr. of Easton, MD, William P. Kennedy of Easton, MD, and Robbie Kennedy of Tallahassee, FL; seven grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren. Three children predeceased him, Steven Kennedy, Robert Kennedy, and Lillian Kennedy.
