January 31, 1927 - January 30, 2015

Harold Main of Rock Hall, MD, died on January 30, 2015, at Manor Care Nursing Home in New Jersey. He was 87 and 364 days old.

He was born on January 31, 1927 in Garden City, MO, the son of the late John and Viola Mae Ackerman Main.

Mr. Main enlisted in the Merchant Marines at the age of 17 and served two years in the Pacific Theatre. Upon his honorable service he returned and married his pen pal, Flora Burriss in 1945. Together they started their lives in Deptford, NJ, and began a family. Mr. Main worked as a lather working with wood, wire, and metal with the Philadelphia Carpenters Union. In 1977, he and his wife moved to Rock Hall, MD, where he worked with home repairs, remodeling, and construction. They rebuilt their homes on Haven Road and later Hynson Road.

Mr. Main enjoyed woodworking, watching old movies, telling stories and spending time with his family. He was a member of Sgt. Preston Ashley, American Legion Post #228 Rock Hall, and the Rock Hall Seventh Day Adventist Church.

In addition to his wife ,he is survived by daughters, Carol Ford of Mantua, NJ, Joanne Pruitt of Flemington, NJ, Jane Purvis of Wenonah, NJ, and Bonnie

Steen of Deptford, NJ; his son, John Main of Mansfield, NJ, two sisters, Virginia Kimbrell and Sally Prasifka, both of KS; and two brothers, Henry Main of KS and LeRoy Main of OH. He is also survived by 13 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, February 3, 2015, at 11:00 A.M. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD, where relatives and friends may visit from 10:00-11:00. 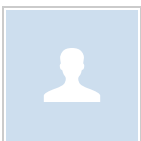

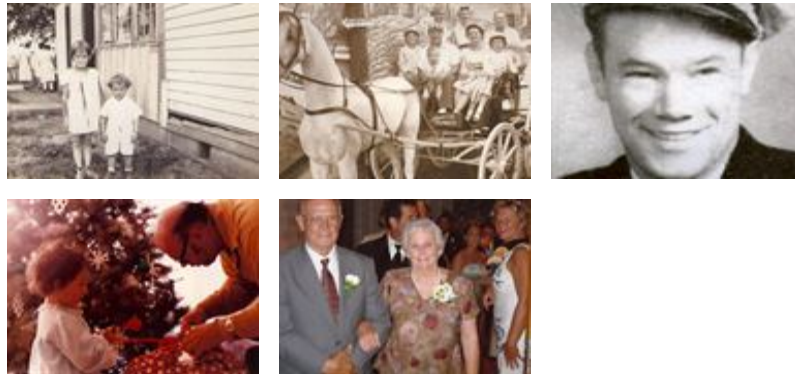

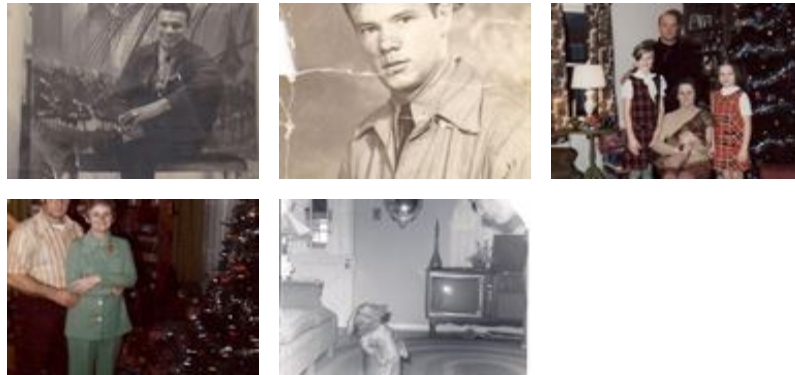
