



Harold Copper Williams Jr.

June 23, 1929 - May 15, 2017

Harold Copper Williams, Jr., of Trappe, MD, died at his home on May 15, 2017. He was 87.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, June 23, 1929, he was the son of the late Harold C., Sr. and Evelyn Carter Williams. After graduating from Chestertown High School in 1947, he worked at a local dairy company until joining the U.S. Coast Guard in 1952, where he served in the North Atlantic on the USCGC Absecon.

Following his release from active duty, in 1963, he returned to Chestertown to work at the dairy company until its close in 1966. He then entered the food service business and worked at the Water Wheel Inn in Doylestown, PA. In 1969, he moved to Easton where he worked at the Easton Manor Inn until 1972 when he purchased the Oxford Carryout in Oxford, MD. This business was re-named the Town Creek Restaurant Marina, where he remained active until he sold it in 1984. In 1988, he became the manager for the Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford, a position he held until again retiring in 1994.

A resident of Trappe since 1984, he was a member of Easton Elks Lodge #1622, an Honorary Member of the Oxford Volunteer Fire Co. and a life member of the Tred Avon Yacht Club.

He enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was inspirational in the building of the new Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford. He enjoyed traveling to Switzerland, to France, and the Greenbriar with the Culinary Institute of New York for Chef Training.

Mr. Williams is survived by his wife, the former M. Michele Potter, whom he married in June 1986; one daughter, Cindy Williams (Willy) of Chestertown, MD; a sister, Joyce Evelyn Wood of Starr, MD; and two nephews, Lawrence Wood and Vic Wood.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his daughter, Lisa Bishop.

A funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM, on Monday, May 22, 2017, at St. Mark's United Methodist Church 100 Peachblossom Road, Easton, MD 21601, where family and friends may call one hour prior. Burial will follow at Oxford Cemetery in Oxford, MD.

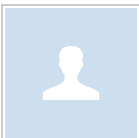
