



## Harriet Freeman Johnson

May 27, 1930 - August 6, 2014

Harriet Armstrong Freeman Johnson of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, August 6, 2014, at Mayo Clinic Health Systems in La Crosse, WI. She was 84.

Born on May 27, 1930, in Plattsburgh, NY, she was the daughter of the late Elwyn H. and Sarah E. Kesson Freeman. Harriet had one older sibling, Richard Elwyn Freeman, who passed away several years ago.
