



Harriet L. Stevens

January 14, 1916 - December 11, 2008

Harriet Louise Stevens, of Easton, died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Thursday, December 11, 2008. She was 92.

Born in Lynn, MA on January 14, 1916, she was the daughter of the late Frank and Bessie Colmer Hamill. Following her graduation from Lynn English High School in Lynn, MA she worked at Daniel Lowes in Salem. She was married to Grover T. Stevens and they spent all of their married life together living in Marblehead, MA except for a brief time while Mr. Stevens served as a Lieutenant in the U.S. Navy during WWII. Mr. Stevens died in 1984. Mrs. Stevens remained in Marblehead until two years ago when she moved to Easton to be with her daughter and family.

Mrs. Stevens was a member of St Andrews Episcopal Church in Marblehead, where she served as a guild member. She was an avid bridge player and trustee of the condo association where she lived in Marblehead subsequent to her husband's death. Mrs. Stevens enjoyed sailing with her husband and playing golf.

Harriet Stevens is survived by her daughter; Judith S. Weaver and her husband Larry of Easton, two grandchildren; Ananda Weaver, and Stevens Danvir Weaver.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, December, 20, 2008 at the William Hill Manor Auditorium at 10:00AM.

Burial will be held in Marblehead, MA at a later date.
