Harriett Dillon (Parker) Goodman of Chestertown, Maryland died on Saturday March 31, 2007 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown, Maryland. She was 89.

Mrs. Goodman worked with the Kent County Department of Social Services, the Kent County Board of Education, and Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital.

She was a member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Chestertown, Maryland, the E.G.A. of America, and served as past president of the Ladies Auxiliary for both the Frank M. Jarman American Legion Post #36 in Chestertown, Maryland and The V.F.W. Post 652 in Millington, Maryland. Mrs. Goodman was an accomplished needlework artist.

She is survived by a sister: Jeddie P. DeCoursey of Chestertown, Maryland along with nieces and nephews.
