



Harrison Charles Bristol

February 24, 1926 - January 9, 2017

Harrison Charles Bristoll "Jim", age 90, of Chestertown, MD, died on Monday, January 9, 2017, at St. Peters Assisted Living Center, in Church Hill, MD.

He was the son of the late Harrison C. and Margaret McCann Bristoll. His wife, of sixty-three years, Jane Kibler Bristoll "Jerry", and two daughters, Margaret Perry Bristoll, of Dallas, TX and Jane Bristoll Short (Luke) of Ft. Lauderdale, FL, survives him. His sister, Margaret Bristoll Eddy, predeceased him.

"Jim" as he was known, was born in Florida. He lived most of his life in New Britain, CT, where he grew up and attended public schools. In 1942, he graduated from Vermont Academy in Saxton River, VT. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1944 and served in the Atlantic Ocean area in World War II. He graduated from Dartmouth College in 1950, and was then called back into the Navy during the Korean War. He married Jane Kibler in 1953. After working for Connecticut General Insurance Company, he joined Stanley Works Co. in 1954. He worked in New Britain, CT, and Washington, DC. In 1971, he and his family moved to Chestertown where he remained after retirement. Mr. Bristoll served on the Chestertown town council for several years.
