



## Harry "Tom" Wilson Bramble

September 21, 1931 - March 16, 2024

Harry Wilson Bramble ("Tom") passed away at Easton Hospital in Easton, MD on March 16, 2024. He was 92 years old.

Tom was born on September 21, 1931, in Easton, MD to the late Harry S. Bramble and Ruth Morris Bramble.

He married Marjorie Eileen (Detzel) Bramble on July 4, 1957. Together they raised their daughter, Kathy Shaffer.

Tom entered the United States Air Force and served in the Korean War from 1950 – 1952. After he was honorably discharged, he went on to work at the Star Democrat for 26 ½ years and eventually retired in 1995 with the State of Maryland. Tom received the National Award from the Disabled American Veterans in 1985.

Tom was a lifelong member of the Easton Moose Lodge, American Legion Post 70, and the Disabled American Veterans Organization. One of his most cherished activities was spending time with his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

He is survived by his daughter, Kathy Shaffer (John); grandchildren, Melissa Singleton (Luke), and John Shaffer Jr.; great grandchildren, Zoey Singleton,

and Emily Singleton; sister, Faye Gadow and niece Jenny Harrison.

Along with his parents, Tom is preceded in death by his wife, Marjorie Bramble and his siblings, Ethel Hunt, Barbara Wagner, Homer Bramble, Margaret Harrison, and Jean Grant Ainsworth.

A visitation will be held from 11am – 12pm at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home in Easton, MD on March 21, 2024. A funeral service will follow the visitation starting at 12pm. A graveside service will follow in New Spring Hill Cemetery.

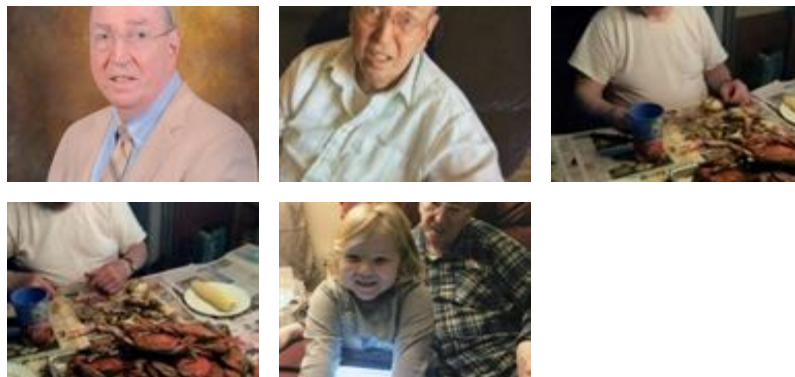
