



## Harry Clifford Harris Jr.

November 19, 1930 - October 19, 2012

Harry C. Harris. Jr., 81, of Cordova, MD, passed away on Friday, October 19, 2012, at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD.

He was born in Caroline County on November 19, 1930, son of the late, Harry Clifford Harris, Sr., and Viola Emily Sard Harris. Mr. Harris attended public schools in Cordova. He later worked at Harris Construction. On February 5, 1949, he married Stella Martha Schmitt. He joined the United States Army on May 18, 1953, and was stationed in Korea until being honorably discharged on March 31, 1955. During that time, he received the Good Conduct Medal. After his discharge, he returned to work in the family construction business. He later worked for James Julian, Inc., retiring after more than thirty five years of service.

Mr. Harris instilled his love of the outdoors and animals in his children and grandchildren. He enjoyed hunting and camping with his family. He was a member of the American Beagle Club and Trotters Association. Through the years, he raised and trained Beagles for field trails. With his father, he also trained thoroughbred race horses. In his later years, he was essential in helping his daughter on the family farm. He was happiest on the tractor or taking care of the chickens and goats.

In addition to his wife of 63 years, Stella M. Harris, he is survived by a son,

Harry Clifford Harris, III, and a daughter, Crystal Callahan, both of Cordova. He is also survived by his grandsons, Harry C. Harris, IV, of SC, Shelby Harris of Cordova, Norman "Chip" L. Schuyler of Puerto Rico, Paul Callahan of Trappe; and his granddaughter, Carrie Harris of Cordova; three great-grandchildren; a brother; Robert L. Harris and his wife, Lovie. He also leaves behind several nieces, nephews, and his faithful companion, Daisy. He was preceded in death by brothers, Stanley P. Harris and Ivan P. Harris, and a sister, Irene E. Mayer.

A graveside service will be held on Wednesday, October 24, 2012, at 11 a.m. at Springhill Cemetery in Easton.
