Harry Richard “Dick” Norman, 83, of Greensboro, MD, died on Monday, May 7, 2018 at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was born on November 30, 1934, in PA, the son of the late Harry R. Norman and Frances Susemihl.

Dick graduated from Swarthmore High School and Pennsylvania Military College. He served honorably in the United States Army and the Maryland National Guard. Dick began his career teaching high school at St. Michaels High School as an English teacher. He loved teaching. Later, he changed professions and had 30 years of service with Ohio Casualty Insurance Company. After deciding not to retire, he began a second career of 18 years with Bartlett, Griffin, and Vermilye, who were like a second family to him.
