Harry Benton Porter, Jr., a former resident of Kent Island, died at the Queen Anne's Hospice Center, Centreville, MD, on Monday, August 26, 2013. He was 71.

Born May 19, 1942, in Chester, MD, he was the son of the late Captain Harry Benton Porter, Sr., and Alice Anna Pinder. He attended Stevensville High School and worked as a waterman early on, crabbing and hand tonging for oysters in the Chesapeake Bay. Later in life he enjoyed delivering flowers for Lori's Flower Boutique. Fishing and watching baseball and football games were some of his favorite pastimes.
