Harry E. King of Chester died on Thursday, March 7, 2002 at his home. He was 66.

Born on August 24, 1935 in Patuxent, Maryland he was the son of the late William and Hazel Neary King. He attended school at Arundel High School in Gambrills. Mr. King served in the U.S. Navy for four years, serving from January 27, 1953 to January 26, 1961. He worked for the Bowie Race Track as a track keeper, then for Reliable Contractors operating heavy equipment, later for the U.S. Post Office in Bowie for eighteen years. Mr. King moved to Chester in 1981. He was a member of the American Legion Post #278 in Stevensville. He also enjoyed crabbing, fishing, gardening, and cutting grass for his neighbors.

Mr. King is survived by a son, Richard W. King of Edgewater; a brother, William Leo King and his wife Bernice H. of Severn; a granddaughter, Jennifer L. King of Stevensville; and three special friends, Larry Lambert, Jim Spedden and Colin Martin.

Graveside services will be held 10:00AM on Wednesday, March 13, 2002 at Maryland National Memorial Cemetery in Laurel, Maryland.
