



## Harry Glenn Hickman

Harry Glenn Hickman, of Easton, died Friday May 19, 2000 near Seattle, Washington while on a vacation trip . He was 75.

Born in Princess Anne, MD, April 23, 1925, he was the son of the late Harry Milton and Mabel Bradd Hickman. After graduating from Washington High School in Princess Anne in 1942, he served in the United States Army in the European Theatre of Operations during WWII. Shortly after his release from active duty in 1946, he was employed by the Coca-Cola Company. He retired from the company in the late 1980"s as a refrigeration technician with thirty five years of service.

A resident of Easton since 1949, he was a charter member and former trustee of the Presbyterian Church Of Easton and a member of E. E. Streets Memorial Post 5118, VFW and the B.P.O. Elks Lodge # 1622, both in Easton.

Mr. Hickman is survived by his wife, the former Julia "Judy" Ann Powell whom he married in Princess Anne in 1948: a son, Bradd S. Hickman, of Ocean Pines, MD. and two sisters, Lucille H. Causey of Delmar, DE. and Peggy Jean Hickman of Princess Anne, MD.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday May 24 at 1 PM at the Presbyterian Church in Easton.

Burial will be at the Maryland Veterans Cemetery- Eastern Shore, Hurlock.
