



Harry J. "Buddy" Hubbard

September 21, 1919 - February 9, 2009

Harry J. "Buddy" Hubbard of Easton, MD died on Monday, February 9, 2009 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 89.

Born September 21, 1919 near Denton, he was the son of the late Harry H. and Lila Spicher Hubbard. After graduation from Denton High School, he began a 6-year career in the U.S. Navy. He served on the battleship USS New York in the Caribbean Sea which did convoy duty in the North Atlantic. He then served on submarine chasers in the South Pacific and with merchant ships in the Pacific. Following his release from active duty, he went to work for Delmarva Power & Light, retiring in 1979 as District Manager in the Oxford office after 40 years of service.

Mr. Hubbard was a member of Christ Episcopal Church in Easton, the American Institute of Electrical Engineers, the Easton Rotary Club where he served as President in 1966, a board member of the Easton Housing Authority for many years, and a member at large of the Memorial Hospital Foundation. He was a member of Coates Lodge #102, a former member of the Talbot and Caroline County Country Clubs, and a former member of the Boy Scouts of America Council. He was also a member of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622, E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W. in Easton, and a past Post Commander of American Legion Post #29 in Caroline County.

Mr. Hubbard is survived by his wife, the former Carolyn Payne, whom he married in 1947; two children, Carolyn H. Corrigan and her husband Richard of Bethany Beach, DE, and Michael H. Hubbard of Fredericksburg, VA; his daughter-in-law, Kathleen S. Donlon of Long Island, NY; two sisters, Eleanor Irwin of Frederick, MD and Elizabeth Weldon of Michigan; one granddaughter, Kathryn H. Frazier and her husband Robert of Frederick, MD; and three great-grandchildren, Colin, Ryan, and Sadie Frazier.

Services will be held on Friday, February 13, 2009 at 11:00 AM at Christ Episcopal Church, Easton.

Burial will be at Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
