Harry L. Griffith of Stevensville, Maryland died Friday August 19, 2011 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home. He was 87.

Born June 4, 1924 in New Freedom, Pennsylvania he was the son of the late, Louis and L. May Frank Griffith. He graduated from Arendtsville High School class of 1943. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII on a destroyer the Daniel A. Joy mostly in the Pacific. On November 15, 1957 he married Eileen F Feick of Baltimore, MD.
