Harry Mitchell Wilkinson, Jr. of Centreville, MD died at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD on Thursday, May 27, 2004. He was 83.

Born March 21, 1921 in Cleveland, OH, he was the son of the late Harry M. Wilkinson, Sr. and Carolyn Zimmer Wilkinson. He grew up in Johnstown, OH during the Johnstown Flood. Following his graduation from high school he married the former, Ruth E. Fentress. During World War II he enlisted in the Merchant Marines. Following the war he began construction as a heavy equipment operator working in Virginia, Ohio, Delaware and Maryland until retiring in the early 1970's. He lived on Clabber Hill Road where he operated a machine shop known as Wilkie's Machine Shop in Centreville. He then worked for the State of Maryland as a mechanic in Centreville. During his retirement he worked for the local sand pit.

He loved boating and always had a boat, he enjoyed dancing and country music. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge, VFW and the American Legion Jeff Davis Post.

Mr. Wilkinson is survived by his daughter, Dyanne R. Jones of Satellite Beach, FL; two sons, Harry Mitchell Wilkinson, III of Newark, DE and William H. Wilkinson of Harrisburg, PA; ten grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.

Memorial service will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Centreville, Saturday, June 12, 2004 at 11:00 AM.

Private interment will be at All Saints Cemetery, Wilmington, DE.
