Harry W. Larrimore, affectionately known as Captain Harry, of Tilghman, MD passed away on Wednesday, March 22, 2006 at Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis, MD. He was 84.

Born December 19, 1921 in Tilghman, MD, he was the son of the late Harvey W. and Mary Roe Larrimore. He attended public school in Talbot County. At age 16 began taking out fishing parties, and earned his Captain's License at age 18. He then served in the U.S. Navy. Following his release from active duty, he worked at Bethlehem Steel. Upon returning to Tilghman, he devoted his life to working on the water while also working on Cove Point Farm.

His wife, the former Anna Margaret Elliott, whom he married November 1, 1941, died November 15, 1995.

He was a member of the Tilghman United Methodist Church.

Captain Harry is survived by two grandchildren whom he raised, Kimberly Jones and her husband Steve of Wittman, and Kevin Cummings and his wife Maria of Tilghman; two great-grandchildren, Laura Jones and Travis Jones, both of Wittman; a brother, Woody Faulkner of Tilghman; and his dear companion, Carrie Payne of Tilghman. He was predeceased by his daughter, Barbara Ann Cummings who died in 1968 and a brother, John Larrimore.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, March 27, 2006 at 2:00 PM at Tilghman United Methodist Church, Tilghman, MD. Friends may call on Sunday, March 26th from 3 to 5 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD and at the church on Monday one hour prior to the service.

Burial will be at Tilghman Memorial Cemetery, Tilghman, MD.
