



Harry Weller Barrick

Harry Weller Barrick Jr. passed away on Tuesday, September 18, 2007 at Easton Memorial Hospital from complications from Amyloidosis while surrounded by his loving family. He was 78 years old.

Born on October 9, 1928 in Woodsboro, MD, Mr. Barrick is the son of the late Harry W. Barrick, Sr. and Marie Stambaugh. He grew up in Woodsboro and was a graduate of Charlotte Hall Military Academy class of 1947. He served in the Army during the Korean War where he was commissioned at The Armored School at Fort Knox, KY and was honorably discharged from active duty on December 18, 1953. Mr. Barrick continued his education at Gettysburg College where he received his bachelor's degree in physics. He joined the C&P Telephone Company in 1956 as an Engineer, working with the Company in Baltimore, New Jersey and Washington DC areas over his 32 year career. In the early 70's, as Division Engineering Manager for Buildings, Mr. Barrick was in charge of building the Constellation Place, C&P Headquarters on Pratt and Light Streets in Inner Harbor of Baltimore. A longtime resident of Severna Park MD, Mr. Barrick moved to Queenstown in 1986 where he enjoyed the recreation of eastern shore life along the Wye River, such as boating, golfing, and biking. He was a board member of SW Barrick Lime Company; a charter member of the Kent Island Rotary Club where he was a Paul Harris Recipient and was very active with the Boy Scouts of America. He was a recipient of the Boy Scout's Silver Beaver Award in 1980 for his years of distinguished service

to youth. During retirement Mr. Barrick also worked as a starter for the Atlantic Golf at Queenstown Harbor in Queenstown, MD.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years the former Helen Rebecca Barrick of Queenstown, MD; a daughter Lorraine B. Summers of New Orleans, LA; two sons, Harry W. Barrick, III of Fallston, MD and Karl F. Barrick of Pasadena, MD; a brother Samuel W. Barrick of Frederick, MD; a sister Betty B. Wachs of Hagerstown, MD; 9 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren. A sister Bradley B. Thomas predeceased him.

A visitation will be held at the Fellow, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD where family and friends may call on Friday, September 21st from 2 to 4 pm and 6 to 8 pm. A graveside service will be held on Saturday, September 22nd at 1 pm at Woodsboro Cemetery in Woodsboro, MD.
