Hartwell "Harvey" Macon King of Stevensville, MD, passed away on February 23, 2018, at his home. He was 81.

Born on January 31, 1937, at Maryland General Hospital, the son of the late Nellie B. and Hartwell Macon King, who was an attorney. Harvey graduated from Clifton Park and went to Strawbridge from November 1949- August 1952. He was a Strawbridge Boy.
