

Harvey Jack Phillips

March 6, 1940 - April 7, 2018

Harvey “Jack” Phillips, 78, of Easton, MD, went to be with the Lord on April 7, 2018, at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center in Easton.

He was born in Wrightsville, PA, on March 6, 1940, the son of the late Herbert Kauffman Phillips and Elizabeth Fox McHenry Phillips.

Jack graduated from Hermiston High School, OR, in the Class of 1958. He attended Linfield College 1958/1959 in McMinnville, OR, where he played baseball. He also attended Washington State University in Pullman, WA, in 1960/1961. He served honorably in the U.S. Army National Guard in Washington State for seven years.

Jack married the former Gail Batterman on August 27, 1961, in Wenatchee, WA. They moved to Springfield, VA, in 1974, where they made their home for 23 years before moving to Easton in 2002.

He was employed with Levitz Furniture in management and a member of the First Baptist Church of Easton. Jack loved the Eastern Shore of Maryland and had a passion for sailing.
