Hazel Eugene Callahan, 82, of Easton, MD, died on Wednesday, December 14, 2011, at his home. Born in Longwoods, near Easton, on November 18, 1929, he was the son of the late Alton Nicholas Callahan and Margaret Favinger Callahan.

Mr. Callahan was employed with the Talbot County Public Works Department for many years, retiring in 1991. He also enjoyed farming. He served in the United States Army during World War II. Mr. Callahan loved riding horses and was an active member in the Jollie Circle Horse Club. Hazel loved people and was always the life of the party when getting together with family and friends.

He is survived by a brother, Carlton N. Callahan (Virginia) of Easton; a sister, Rita C. Callaway (Toby) of Queenstown; a niece, Mollie C.
