



Hazel Mandrell Callaway

November 29, 1923 - April 2, 2012

Hazel “Toby” Mandrell Callaway of Queenstown, MD, died on Monday, April 2, 2012, at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 88.

Born November 29, 1923, in Queen Anne, MD, he was the son of the late Hazel and Lula Mandrell Callaway. He grew up in Queen Anne’s County, and he served in the U.S. Army during World War II. In 1951, he married the former Rita Callahan, and they made their home in Queenstown, MD. During his lifelong career of farming he had been Honored as Farmer of the Year. He had been a dairy farmer for 30 years and continued grain farming until he was 81 years old.

His greatest love was his family. He was an avid fox hunter and was a member of the Hunter and Hound Club. He was also involved in sulky horse racing.

In addition to his wife, Rita Callaway, he is survived by a son, H. Lee Callaway and his wife Linda Dean Callaway of Centreville, MD; a daughter, Mollie Callaway Scharnus and her husband Joseph of Stevensville, MD; a half sister, Lorraine Cook of Centreville, MD; a nephew, Michael F. Callahan and his wife Deanna of Richmond, VA; four grandchildren, Kirby L. Callaway, Amy Hollis, Katelyn Scharnus and Sarah Scharnus; a great-grandson, Mason Hollis; a grand niece, Hillary Callahan; and a grand nephew, Brandon Callahan. He

was pre-deceased by a sister, Catherine Cook, and stepmother, Lillian Callaway.

Funeral services will be held at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Centreville, MD, on Tuesday, April 10, 2012, at 11 .m. where friends may call from 10 a.m. - 11 a.m.
