Harry Bushey Baker died on Saturday September 27, 2003 at his home. He was 73.

Born in Washington DC, but raised in Hyattsville, MD, he was the son of the late Elmer and Lillian Sauble Baker. A graduate of Hyattsville High School class of 1947, he enlisted in the National Guard and then transferred into the U.S. Air Force, serving in the Korean conflict where he earned the Korean Service Medal and the United Nations Service Medal.

In 1953 Mr. Baker married Margaret "Peggy" Regina Branson of Washington DC. Mrs. Baker died July 22, 1982. In 1986 he married the former, Ruth Booze Quimby of Chester, MD.

Mr. Baker worked for Western Electric as a Supervisor for 35 years, retiring in 1983.
