H. Callaway Harrison of St. Michaels, MD died on Thursday, September 15, 2005 at Coastal Hospice at The Lake, Salisbury, MD. He was 84.

Born June 10, 1921 in Baltimore County, he was the son of the late H. Callaway, Sr. and Flora I. Milburn Harrison. After graduating from Catonsville High School, he attended Loyola College in Baltimore City. He was then inducted into the U.S. Navy during World War II. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Loyola College where he received his degree. In 1946 he married the former Mary Marshall. They made their home in St. Michaels where he owned and operated Covington Oil Company. After his retirement, he and his wife operated Cottage Antiques in St. Michaels. Mr. Harrison specialized in antique tools and remained active in the business until the time of his death.

An avid boater, he was a former member of the Miles River Yacht Club and the St. Michaels Rotary.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Harrison is survived by two children, Steven C. Harrison and his wife Janice of Annapolis, MD and Marsha H. Kemp of Easton, MD; a sister, Jane Grafton of Stevensville, MD; and his two grandchildren, Sam and Jenny Kemp who were such a very important part of his life. He was predeceased by a sister, Charlotte Bryson.

Funeral services will be held on Monday, September 19, 2005 at 2:30 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Easton, MD.

Burial will be at Mt. Olivet Cemetery, St. Michaels, MD.
