Helen B. Arkey of Chestertown, MD died on February 1, 2009 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was 93.

She was born on August 23, 1915 in Bethlehem, PA she was the daughter of the late John and Anna (Dera) Boylics. She attended the Washington School in Bethlehem, PA. In 1932 she married the late John Arkey, Jr.

Mrs. Arkey raised her daughter in Bethlehem, PA. During her career she did domestic work in New York and worked for Bethlehem Steel in the Steel Annealing Department. After World War II she returned to New York and worked at First Bank of New York City as a clerk. She then returned to Allentown, PA and worked for Hess's Department Store in customer service where she eventually retired.

She moved to Chestertown, MD in May of 1987. Mrs. Arkey was a member of St. Johns Capistrano Catholic Church in Bethlehem, PA, attended Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Chestertown, and Rock Hall Seniors Center. She enjoyed dancing and playing cards.
