



Helen Naomi Beckering

October 30, 1923 - February 19, 2018

Helen Beckering died on February 19, 2018, in Chestertown, MD, at age 94. Born in Baltimore, MD, on October 30, 1923, she was the daughter of the late Edward H. Robinson, Sr., and Edith McFadden Robinson.

After graduating from Bel Air High School, Bel Air, MD, she attended Bard-Avon Secretary School in Baltimore. From there she started her career working for the US Army's Chemical Warfare Services in Edgewood, MD. In 1946, she joined the Army and was assigned to AAF Regional Station Hospital, San Antonio, TX, later securing a position with the Department of Defense, attached to NATO in Paris, France. It was not long after, also in Paris, that she met her future husband, Jacobus Jan Beckering. They were married on September 5, 1959 in Berkel, Netherlands, and returned to the U.S. where she raised her family. Along with her husband and children, she lived in Maryland, South Carolina, Ontario, Illinois, New York, and Michigan.

She and her husband retired to Easton and finally settled in Chestertown, MD. Her passions were her family, gardening and golfing. Although not fond of water, she spent many summers with her husband and children on their boats - either on the Chesapeake Bay or the St. Lawrence River.

She is predeceased by her husband and survived by her daughters, Laura F. Beckering (George Cooke) of Old Greenwich, CT, Dorothea L. Beckering

Crescenze (Paul) of Chestertown, MD; her sons, Jan Dereck H. Beckering of Germantown, MD, Thomas W.K. Beckering (Jeanette) of Little Britain, Ontario, Canada; nine grandchildren, five great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews.

There will be a celebration of Life for Helen on Saturday, March 3 from 1-3 p.m, where the family will be receiving friends and relatives at the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown, 905 Gateway Dr, Chestertown, MD. Burial will be private.
