December 31, 1924 - September 27, 2012

Helen E. Berry of Easton, Maryland died on Thursday, September 27, 2012, at Easton Memorial Hospital after suffering a stroke. She was 87.

Born December 31, 1924, in Detroit, Michigan, she was the daughter of Irvin C. and Eva M. Staeuble.

In 1946, Helen earned a BS degree in journalism from the University of Missouri, the oldest formal journalism school in the world. After graduation, she lived and worked in New York City for a number of years as an editor for Crown Books. On May 20, 1960, she married Edward Ralph Sterling. After his death, she moved to Rockville, Maryland and later married Richard F. Berry on April 21, 1974. She and Dick moved to Talbot County in 1983, where she continued to live until her death.

Helen loved to travel, both nationally and internationally. She was intelligent and interesting, always inquiring about her nieces, nephew, and friends and caring about what was going on in their lives. She had a love of learning and was well-read, well-informed, and believed in the ability to achieve and succeed through education.

In addition to her parents and both husbands, she is preceded in death by her brother,

Nelson Staeuble.

Helen is survived by her niece Katherine Kinney and her husband Greg, of Washington, Utah, her niece Karen Hearn and her husband Dave of Livermore, California, and her nephew Kurt Staeuble and his wife Sara, of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho. She is also survived by eight great nieces and nephews, and three great, great nieces.
