Helen Virginia Cannon of Chestertown, Maryland died Sunday, July 18, 2004 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was 80.

Born August 5, 1923 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of the late John Samuel and Nora May Smith Taylor. She graduated from Sudlersville High School Class of 1940. After graduation she was employed by Merck, Sharpe and Dome Pharmaceutical Company in Philadelphia. On July 14, 1945 she married A. Edward Cannon of Ingleside, Maryland and they raised their family in Ingleside and Church Hill, Maryland. She worked as a switchboard operator at the Kent and Queen Anne's hospital from 1969 to 1985.

She was predeceased by Edward, her husband of 54 years, on December 8, 1999; one son, Stewart Cannon on January 9, 1976; two brothers, John Taylor and Joseph Taylor and four sisters, Elma Cramer, Rachel Davis, Mabel Fetterolf, and Ruth Taylor.

In recent years she was a member of First United Methodist Church in Chestertown. She was an excellent seamstress and she loved to quilt, cook, and read.
