



## Helen G. Ewing

October 14, 1937 - September 12, 2014

Helen Geib Ewing, longtime resident of Talbot County, passed away peacefully in her home with her husband by her side on September 12, 2014. She was 76 years old.

Born on October 14, 1937, in Ridgely, MD, she was the daughter of Milby and Louise Geib. She lived in Queen Anne and grew up on a family farm in Cordova. She moved to Easton after marrying her high school sweetheart, Gene Ewing, on January 31, 1954, in Saints Peter & Paul Church. Father Irwin presided over their marriage.
