



## Ms. Helen Haight

July 22, 1920 - July 19, 2012

Helen Boesch Haight of Easton, went home to the Lord, Thursday, July 19, 2012 at Memorial Hospital in Easton.

Born July 22, 1920 in Washington DC, to the late, Ethel Swaine and Paul Boesch. Mrs. Haight attended Woodrow Wilson High School where she was in the Glee Club and President of the Buskin and Masque Club. She was a Girl Scout, earning several merit badges. She attended Wilson Teachers College and Strayers College where she was President of the Alpha Iota Sorority.

Mrs. Haight worked for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Legal Division of Reconstruction Finance Corporation, Rubber Reserve. During the war years she received several commendations for helping in the war effort and for the Red Cross.

Helen married John J. Haight on May 7, 1949 and moved to Maryland. She worked for the State Department, Near Eastern Affairs, and U.S. Public Health Service, Radiological Health.

In 1972, she and her husband retired to a home on Irish Creek, Royal Oak, MD, where they enjoyed hunting and fishing. They lived there for 25 years and in 1997 built a house at Easton Club, MD and have resided there since. She and her husband traveled extensively throughout all 50 states and visited

many foreign countries.

She has served on boards of Talbot Dance Club, Edge Creek Boat club, Talbot County Women's Club, AARP, and the Royal Oak Community United Methodist Church where she has been a member since 1972. Helen also volunteered at the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum, Historical Society in Easton, and Jr. Auxiliary at Memorial Hospital and she was a member of the Ladies of the Elks.

Mrs. Haight is survived by her devoted husband, John; two sisters, Ruth Fulton, of Easton, and Alice Norair, of Annapolis; a brother, David Boesch, of Walnut Creek, CA; and a number of nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held at the Royal Oak Community Methodist Church in Royal Oak at 11am on Monday, July 30.
