September 4, 1927 - August 6, 2018

Helen Phipps Weise died on Monday, August 6, 2018, at UMSMC at Easton. She was 90.

Born September 4, 1927, in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late Harry and Ada Fatum Phipps.

Helen graduated from Forest Park High School in Baltimore in 1947. On October 26, 1949, she married the late David Newell Weise.
