



## Helena Marie Graham Perry

June 1, 1933 - June 30, 2023

Helena Marie Graham Perry of Chestertown, MD, died on Friday June 30, 2023, at the Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was 90 years old.

Helena was born on her family's farm near Sudlersville, MD, on June 1, 1933, the daughter of the late Medford B. and Margaret Schauber Graham and the youngest of 14 children. She was a graduate of Sudlersville High School Class of 1951. She married David T. Perry in 1952, and they spent the majority of their married life in Avondale, PA, until she moved to Chestertown in 2021. Her husband predeceased her in 2014. Twelve of her thirteen siblings also predeceased her.

Mrs. Perry worked as a computer programmer with the DuPont Chemical Company for over 36 years, retiring in 1989. She was an active member with The Assumption Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Parish in West Grove, PA, and was also very active with the Red Cross, helping with countless blood drives. Helena loved to ride motorcycles, and she and her husband traveled extensively on their bikes. They were also active boaters and enjoyed spending extended time on Tilghman Island, MD, and in Sun City, FL.

Helena is survived by her sister, Betty G. Queen of Warrenton, VA; her sister-in-law, Margaret J. Graham of Chestertown, MD; 46 nieces and nephews;
