Helen D. Windmiller, of Easton, died at the Wm. Hill Health Care Center, Easton, on Friday, December 14, 2001. She was 93.

Born at Carmichael in Queen Anne's County, February 4, 1908, she was the last surviving of eleven children born to the late James F. and Frances A. Bishop Dodd.

After graduating from public school, she attended a beauty school in Wilmington, DE. After graduating, she moved to Easton where she owned and operated her own beauty shop until her marriage in August of 1950 to Carl R. Windmiller, Sr. Together, they owned and operated Riley's Restaurant in Easton until its sale in 1962 and Windy's Drive-In Restaurant on Route 50 from 1960 until its sale in 1970.

A member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Easton and the United Methodist Women of the church, she was also a member and Past Worthy Matron of the Easton Chapter #65 of the Order of the Eastern Star. She was awarded the Woman of The Year Award by the Easton Business and Professional Women's Club. Her hobbies included gardening and cooking.

Mr. Windmiller died on November 16, 1990. Surviving are two sons, Carl R. Windmiller of Berlin and David H. Windmiller of Glen Burnie; seven

grandchildren; fifteen great-grandchildren and one great-great grandchild.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, December 18th at 2 P.M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton. Burial will follow at the Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
