April 1, 1915 - March 13, 2009

Helen Elizabeth Shallcross, of Rock Hall died Friday, March 13, 2009 at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation. She was 93.

Ms. Shallcross was born on April 1, 1915 to the late Preston Jones and Nettie Mullikin Shallcross. She received her Bachelor of Arts from Washington College in 1938 and her Masters in Education from Johns Hopkins University in 1954. She served as head teacher at The Salvation Army Day Nursery School in Baltimore from 1948 to 1951. She worked with the William S. Baer School in Baltimore, teaching students with hearing and communications impairments from 1951 to 1968. From 1968 until her retirement in 1977, she worked in the Rock Hall School System as a special education/elementary resource room teacher.

Ms. Shallcross was a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church, where she was also a Sunday school teacher, member of the Administrative Board of Trustee, She also served on the United Methodist Women local and as an Eastern District officer. Ms. Shallcross was a member of Kent County Retired Teacher Association and the Maryland Retired Teachers Association, after 31 years of teaching.

She is predeceased by two brothers: Robert Shallcross and George Shallcross, one sister Jeanette S Hall.

She is survived by several nieces and nephews, Robert Hall, Mary MacDermott, Helen Hall, John Hall, Bo Hall, William Shallcross, George Shallcross Jr., Pamela Dorau, Dave Shallcross, Jamie Shallcross, and Jeannie Rance. Also survived by many close friends, including special friends and care takers, Betty Tucker and Janet Elliott.
