Helene Brannock Anthony of Centreville died at the University of Maryland Hospital, Baltimore on Thursday, January 17, 2002. She was 73.

Born May 30, 1928 in Cambridge, MD, she was the daughter of the late Samuel E. Brannock, Jr. and the late Helen Virginia Bramble Brannock. She graduated from St. Mary's Female Seminary and Jr. College in St. Mary's City, MD. She received her B.A. Degree in History and English in 1949 and her Master's of Education Degree in 1967, all from the University of Maryland. On July 9, 1949 she married Charles E. Anthony, Jr. of Centreville, Md. She taught at Hyattsville High School, Hyattsville, MD from 1949 – 1951 and at Centreville High School from 1952-1953. At this point of her life, she started her family. In 1966 she resumed her teaching career at Sudlersville High School until her retirement as Supervisor of Middle Schools for the Board of Education of Queen Anne County in 1988.

She was a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church. While attending the University of Maryland, she was a member of the Gymkana Troupe and the Kappa Delta Sorority. During her career in education, she was a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society (an international honor society of women educators), the Queen Anne's County Education Association, the Maryland State Teachers Association, a member of the National Education Association, Past Delegate to the Queen Anne's Education Association, Past

Secretary of the Maryland Middle School Forum, and one of the Founders of the Middle School Forum. Mrs. Anthony was a Past Secretary of the Corsica River Yacht Club, a member of the American Legion Ladies Auxiliary, the Queen Anne's County Retired Teachers Association and an active member of the American Association of Retired People.

Mrs. Anthony is survived by a daughter, Martha Anthony Davidson of Centreville; son, Charles E. Anthony, III of Annapolis; a brother, Samuel E. Brannock, III of Eden, MD and a sister, Carol V. Brannock of Chesapeake City; six grandchildren, Amy Helene Davidson of Sudlersville, Amanda Carol Davidson of Centreville, Theodore Jacob Anthony, Isaac Mason Anthony, Jackson Robert Anthony and Zane Henry Anthony, all of Annapolis. She was pre-deceased by her husband, Charles E. Anthony, Jr.

Funeral services will be held at the Centreville United Methodist Church, Centreville, MD on Monday, January 21, 2002 at 11:00 AM. Relatives and friends may call at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Centreville on Sunday from 4 – 6 PM.

Burial will be at the Chesterfield Cemetery, Centreville, MD.
