



## Helen Loftus McGuire

September 10, 1927 - May 9, 2008

Helen Loftus McGuire of Easton, MD died at her home in Easton, MD on Friday, May 9, 2008. She was 80.

Born September 10, 1927 in Washington, D.C., she was the daughter of the late Francis J. and Ellen Jerrmann Loftus. She attended the Academy of Holy Names, graduating in 1945 with honors. She then continued her education, graduating in 1948 from Georgetown University. During her teenage years, Mrs. McGuire was employed as a clerk with National Geographic Magazine. In 1949 she began working for the federal government with the Department of Defense.

On June 28, 1952, she married Thomas E. McGuire, M.D. During this time she took leave from her job to raise their family. After Mr. McGuire's death in 1965, she returned to work with the federal government where she retired in 1987 after 27 years of service.

Following her retirement, she moved to Easton, MD where she was a member of the Talbot County Historical Society and the YMCA of Talbot County.

Mrs. McGuire is survived by five daughters, Kathleen, Geraldine, Carol, Wendy, and Susan; sister, Ruth; brother, Joseph; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Graveside services will be held on Thursday May 15, 2008 at 1:00 PM at St. Joseph's Catholic Cemetery, Cordova, MD.
