GRASONVILLE: H. Elwood LaBrie of Grasonville, MD died on Thursday, June 27, 2002 at his home. He was 72.

Born on April 15, 1930 in Baltimore, MD he was the son of the late Thomas William LaBrie and Evelyn Blockston. He grew up on Kent Island and later attended Patterson High School in Baltimore. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy and after an honorable discharge, worked for Crown Cork and Seal in Baltimore. On July 9, 1951 he married the former, Betty Lee Smith and they moved back to the Kent Island area where he worked as a waterman, oystering and crabbing the seasonal offerings. In 1958 he worked for United Shellfish as a driver and was their first salesman. He retired after 25 years to work on the water and sluff crabs, evolving into Bay's Best Seafood in Grasonville. He retired in 1995. He truly loved fishing & Eastern Shore living.

Mr. LaBrie is survived by his wife Betty Lee LaBrie of Grasonville; a daughter Janice L. Duty of Queenstown; two sons, James W. LaBrie of Centreville and Henry E.
