Henry W. Borntraeger of Chestertown, MD died Monday, August 18, 2003 in Chestertown. He was 86.

Born on July 10, 1917 in Pittsburgh, PA, he was a grandson of Henry William Borntraeger, a partner in the Carnegie Steel Corporation of Pittsburgh. He attended Shady Side Academy, The Choate School, Boeing Aeronautical School and Stanford University. He is a former resident of Ligonier, PA, Bellport, NY and Medford, NJ.

Mr. Borntraeger was an avid aviation enthusiast. During World War II, he served with the Military Air Transport Service in the South Pacific and Alaska. He was an aviation world record holder, establishing a National Aeronautic Association and World International Airline distance record in 1936.

Mr. Borntraeger is survived by his wife, Constance T. Borntraeger; three children, H. William Borntraeger, III of Saint-Charles-de-Drummond, Quebec, Carl W. Borntraeger of Pittsburgh, PA and Maeva B. Tunstall of Sarasota, Florida; two step-children, Karen Williams of Spotsylvania, VA and Signa Hillis of Grants Pass, OR; nine grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Services will be held at St. Michael's of the Valley Episcopal Church, Rector Pennsylvania on Wednesday, August 27, 2003 at 10:30 AM.
