



Henry "Hank" Kucin Jr.

October 3, 1957 - March 5, 2023

Henry "Hank" Kucin, Jr., passed away suddenly at home on March 5, 2023, at the age of 65. He was a beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, and uncle.

Hank was born on October 3, 1957, the son of Henry, Sr., and Ann Kucin. He grew up in Silver Spring, MD, and graduated from Spring Brook High School with the Class of 1975.

After graduation, he worked for himself as a contractor in building and remodeling. He later enlisted in the U.S. Army, attending the very first co-ed basic training class at Fort Jackson. He was stationed in Augsburg, Germany, as a Morse Code Specialist, along with his wife of 42 years, Joanne Kucin, whom he met in morse code training in Florida. He served in the Army until 1981 and returned to Maryland. He then began working in the technology field for various companies, such as COMSAT and Hewlett Packard, before eventually retiring from Agilent Technologies in 2021.

Hank had a great love of music. He played guitar and drums, along with having a massive CD and album collection. He also enjoyed playing sports of any kind, fishing, skiing, and dirt biking. He loved spending time with his grandson, playing with him and introducing him to all of his hobbies. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and part of the lifetime parish at St.

Bernadette's Catholic Church.

In addition to his wife, Hank is survived by his daughter, Aubrey Stanford (Dylan); brother, Daniel Kucin (Annie, who passed in 2020); grandson, Greyson; nephew, Daniel Jr., and special cousin, James Rink.

Services will be held on Monday, March 13 at 4 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home in Chestertown. A visitation for family and friends will be held one hour prior, from 3 p.m. – 4 p.m. at the funeral home.

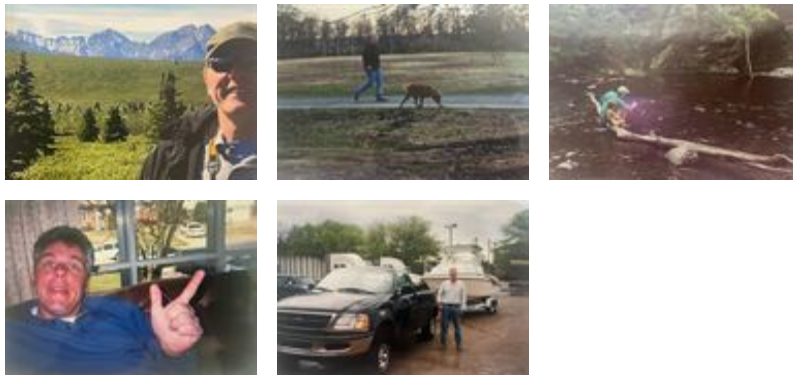
